**SUBJECT: Return to Voluntary Water Conservation
Stage 1 ~ Voluntary Water Use Restrictions**

Effective immediately the City of Marble Falls is returning to voluntary water restrictions.

Voluntary water use restrictions:

Water customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas by irrigating landscapes only between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 a.m. and between 7:00 p.m. and 12:00 midnight on designated outdoor water use days. Customers with even numbered street addresses may water on even numbered days of the month, and customers with odd number street addresses may water on odd number days of the month.

As the hot summer months are behind us and we look forward to cooler temperatures, the City would like customers to continue to water conservatively to allow for preparation of lawns and landscaping for the upcoming winter months.

Water usage has remained much below critical levels due to mandatory restrictions, cooler weather and the cooperation of water customers.

The city believes that we can meet our conservation goals with voluntary restrictions and will continue to monitor usage.

We appreciate your continued efforts on water conservation. Your cooperation has made a difference!
